Two publications are planned, to suit participants at different career stages and with different requirements.

1. A special issue of the open access online journal *Publications* has been negotiated: see [http://www.mdpi.com/journal/publications/special\\_issues/additional\\_language](http://www.mdpi.com/journal/publications/special_issues/additional_language) for full details and how to submit; the deadline for submissions is 15 December 2015. No article publishing charge will be levied for this special issue. The issue title is "Researching, Teaching, and Supporting Research Publication: Issues for Users of English as an Additional Language", and the guest editor will be Margaret Cargill.
2. A proposal will be finalized at the conference for an edited book (softcover book plus free e-book) to be published by the University of Adelaide Press, <https://www.adelaide.edu.au/press/> ). The working title is currently "Dismantling barriers: Communicating research in the 21st century", but this may change once the full range of focuses of the submitted chapters becomes clear. Editors will include Margaret Cargill and Sally Burgess. If you are considering submitting your work as a chapter in this book, please speak with the editors at the conference to discuss the relevance of your contribution to the themes of the conference and the proposed book.
